- **Hold a car wash, talent night, miniature golf tournament, concert, and more. Sell pink ribbons or create a special tee shirt and sell them!**

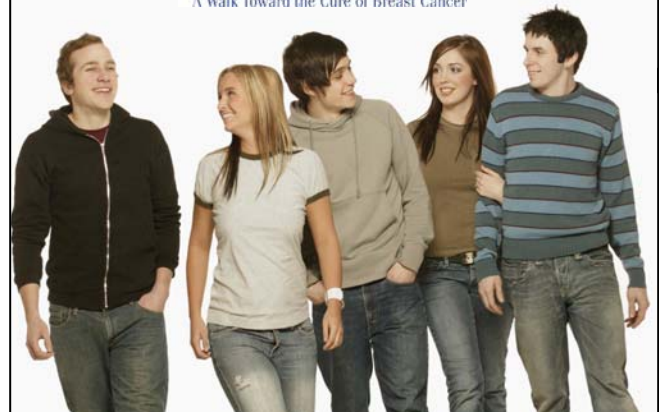
